INVITATION TO BID

Project: Marysville Civic Center

The City of Marysville is requesting sealed bids from contractors to perform, for a stipulated sum, the work specified in the Bidding Documents and Contract Documents for the project identified as: Marysville Civic Center. This is a public works project pursuant to Chapter 39.04 RCW and other provisions of state law.

Base Bid 'A' must be submitted on the basis of the Contract Documents and shall incorporate therein all the laws of the State of Washington. Submit bids Attention: Ms. Gloria Hirashima, Chief Administrative Officer. Alternatively, sealed bids may be handed to Gloria Hirashima or her designee during normal business hours at the administrative reception area of the City of Marysville, 1049 State Avenue, Marysville, Washington. Whether mailed or hand delivered Base Bid 'A' must be received before 2:00 pm, Pacific Daylight Savings Time on November 5, 2019 (the "Bid Opening Day") and the Subcontractor List Section 00 03 10, Base Bid 'B' - Alternates Proposal Section 00 03 01 and the Bid Bond will be due at 3:00 pm. No faxed or emailed bid proposals will be accepted.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid security in the form of a certified check, cashiers check, postal money order or security bond made payable to the order of The City of Marysville, for a sum of not less than 5 percent of the amount of the bid. Incomplete bids and bids received after the day and hour stated above will not receive consideration.

No bidder may withdraw his/her bid after the date and hour set for bid submittal unless the award of the contract is delayed for a period exceeding sixty (60) days.

Substitution requests will not be accepted during the bid process beyond 10 calendar days prior to the bid opening.

Those clearly marked and sealed bids that are timely

received as specified above will be opened at 3:00 pm and publicly read, on the Bid Opening Day, in the Council Chambers. City of Marysville City Hall, 1049 State Avenue, Marysville, Washington and the apparent lowest responsible bidder for both Base Bid 'A' and Base Bid 'B' -Alternate will be announced.

The City of Marysville will then review the proposals (Base Bid 'A' and Base Bid 'B' -Alternate) and may request qualifications of the apparent low Bidders. It is the intent of The City of Marysville to select Base Bid 'B' - Alternate if the bid is within their budget otherwise they will select Base Bid 'A' if that number is within their budget. As part of this review, The City of Marysville may request an interview with the low bidder. Once The City of Marysville confirms the lowest responsible bidder, The City of Marysville shall then promptly proceed with the awarding of the contract to the lowest responsible bidder. If the apparent low bidder is determined not responsible, The City of Marysville will request qualifications of the next low bidder.

The City of Marysville reserves the right to reject all bids and waive any informality in the proposals.

Free-of-charge access to project bid documents (plans, specifications, addenda, and Bidders List) is provided to Prime Bidders, Subcontractors and Vendors by going to www.bxwa.com and clicking on "Posted Projects", "Public Works", and "Marysville Civic Center". The online plan room provides Bidders with fully usable online documents with the ability to download, view, print, order full/partial plan sets from numerous reprographic sources, and a free online digitizer/take-off tool. It is recommended that Bidders

"Register" in order to receive automatic e-mail notification of future addenda and to place themselves on the "Self-Registered Bidders List". Bidders that do not register will not be automatically notified of addenda and will need to periodically check the on-line plan room for addenda issued on this project.
